### 1. REQUEST:

Pursuant to the Department of Education's School Code, Certificated Personnel Policies and Regulations (5000 Series), Regulation #5204 Compensation, Administrative Regulations, Special Compensation Section, item F. Extra Compensation for Personnel Performing Special Duties, number 8. Other special situations approved by the Board of Education (BOE), the Department of Education (Department) respectfully requests the BOE's approval to provide shortage differentials to qualified and licensed teachers to fill vacancies in the areas of Special Education, Hard-to-Staff Geographical locations, and for Hawaiian Language Immersion Programs.

### 2. RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

The recommended effective date for the shortage differential(s) is January 7, 2020. Discussion to occur and action to be taken at the Board's December 5, 2019, General Business meeting.

### 3. DISCUSSION:

The Department's School Code, Policy #5100 Recruitment, Employment, Retention and Termination Policy, Section <u>Teacher Recruitment/Retention/Employment</u>, states in part:
