- Introduction
- Examining/questioning assumptions
  - Ask *reaction questions*  
Examples:
    - *Why is this topic important to you?*
    - *How this infographic appropriate/not appropriate for different cultural groups?*
    - *What do you know about this topic?*
  - Ask *application questions*  
Examples:
    - *How might (parents/teachers/administrators) be expected to respond to this information?*
    - *How does this the application of this information differ in different grades?*
    - *What kinds of beliefs support this information?*
    - *What more do you want to know about this information?*
- Seeking common ground/consensus
  - Ask to audience to determine any common ground among the various viewpoints?
