## FERPA Review as it relates to Classroom Observations

- Protects interest of a child's educational record
- Does not protect confidential information in general
- Applies to tangible records/information from tangible records
- Prohibits disclosure of personally identifiable information in educational records

### **Classroom Observations**

- IDEA no entitlement and no prohibition
- FERPA- no entitlement and no prohibition
- HIDOE Request for Observation Form
  - Purpose
  - Protect the rights of students
  - Third party observation requires parent consent

### **Classroom Observations**

- Follow School's visitor policy
- Accompany observer
- Protect PII (e.g posted or discussed)
- Mutually agreed upon time
- Consider alternate or structured observations


